

Checking of our authorities revealed that "Hertensdorf" was the German name for a village Horní Houžovec which in 1960 became a part of town Knapovec in the District of Ústí nad Orlicí /some 90 miles east from Prague/.

"Pardekitz" is evidently misspelled and surely it is the old German name "Pardubitz" for what is and was Pardubice - a larger city - some 70 miles east from Prague and not so far from Ústí nad Orlicí.
