The book records baptisms from 1872 - 1888 with some years missing in between.

The name for the priest in 1872 appears to be P. Ivo O M Cap

1874 to 1878 P. Joseph Huber

1879 to 1880 H. Victor

1884 to 1885 L Barth

1885 to 1886 J.H. Koetting

1887 H. Victor

1888 the priest did not sign his name

All the preceding names appear also in the records for baptisms at St. Joseph's.

There is a membership listing from the year 1866 written in the old florid German script. It is so difficult to read I made no attempt to re-write it for today.

The above records came to my attention this past week Thursday, September 22, 1977 as I was preparing materials to storage from the old rectory in the new rectory.
